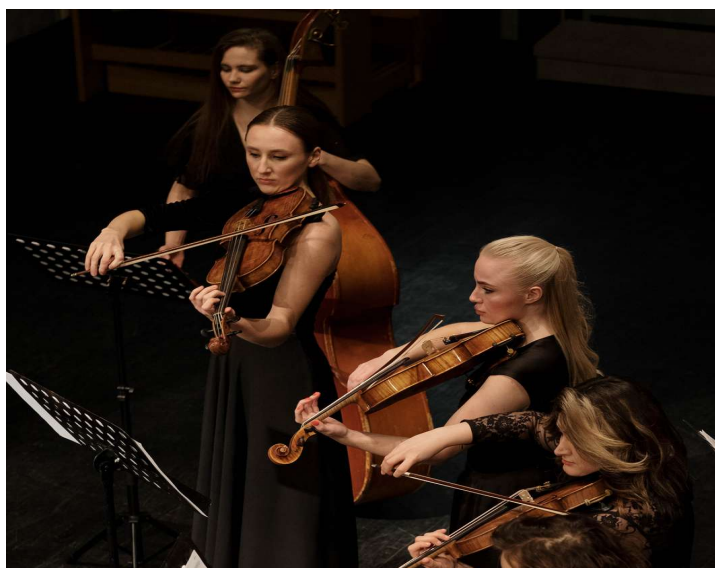




PEAC Pause for Peace Festival
