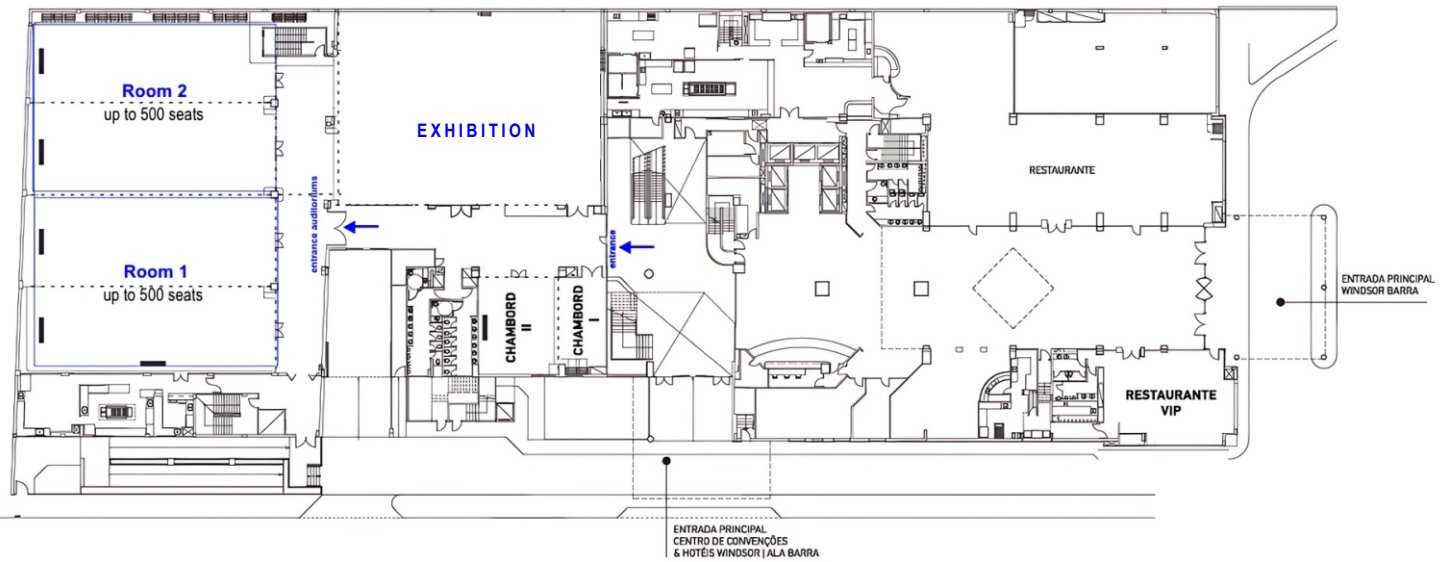
THE EVENT FLOOR PLAN

TÉRREO / GROUND LEVEL WINDSOR BARRA / BARRA SIDE

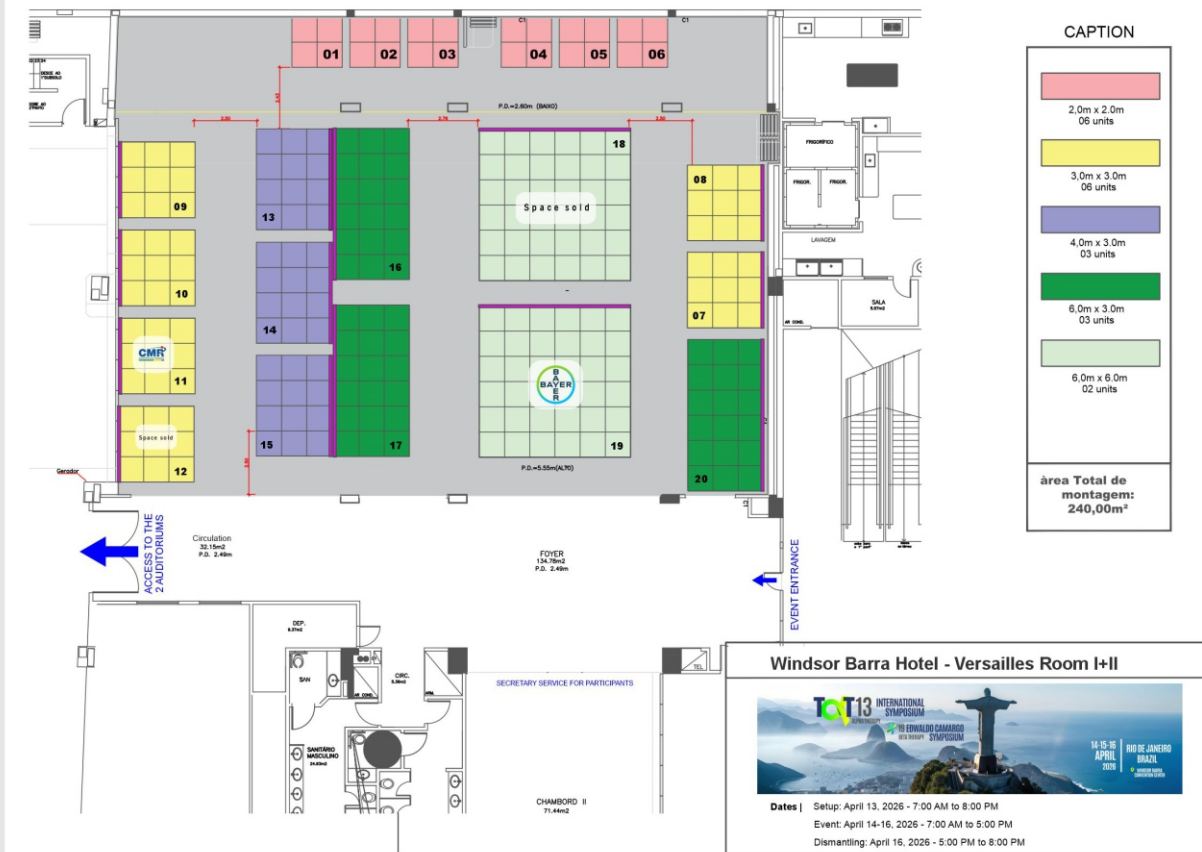

BOOTH DESCRIPTIONS

Booth (6m x 6m | 36m²)

- Built and finished structure and graphite-colored flooring;
- Overhead lighting;
- Three 220V outlets;
- Two white service counters measuring 1.00 meters wide x 1.00 meters high each, with doors and a key, and printing on the front; and four chrome stools with white seats, distributed according to the sponsor's choice;
- Two glass meeting tables and six chairs with white seats;
