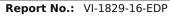

Observations:

✓ Vessel in Good Condition

■ Based on API 510 Visual Internal Inspection this vessel is fit for service

- The Tee welds are numbered West to East T1 T12, and the Circumferential welds are numbered the same C1 C7. The cans are numbered west to east from Can 1 Can 6.
- There is a 3rd party (FOCUS) which is doing TOFD on the welds also. See their results.
- See MT-1829-01-EDP for the WFMPI results and locations.
- See UT-1828-01-MA| for the shear-wave results on the West Head.
- All nozzle welds, circumferential and longitudinal welds have no signs of corrosion, erosion, preferential attack, and issues except on the C7 weld at the 6 O'clock position. The longitudinal weld profile West of T10 from 35 49 inches is flush with the shell wall. There are no issues.
- N1, N2, N3, N4 are on the West Head. N5, N6, N7 are on shell floor in Can 1. M1 and N8 are in Can 1 on top of the shell at the 12 O'clock position. N9 is in Can 6 at 12 O'clock position. This is where the multi-port PSV is mounted. N10 is on the East Head.
- Manway and manway sealing areas have no corrosion, erosion or mechanical damage, or issues.
- Both heads have mill scale still present and have a slight product residue.
- The shell walls have the same slight product residue as the heads and a heavier sludgy residue also noted approximately 1/8 inch thick. There was no corrosion found behind this residue. There are no concerns.
- On the East end of the vessel, there is corrosion noted on the shell floor. The corrosion is out 9" from the C7 weld and is 7" parallel with C7 weld. The deepest area noted in this corrosion on the shell side is 0.040".
- There is minor corrosion noted on the head side which is 1" out from the C7 weld and 6" long that runs parallel with the C7 weld and the deepest area found is 0.010".
- The volume gauge mechanism on the west head is functional but requires to be calibrated as it shows a volume when empty operations were notified.

- The float mechanisms were pulled out and laid upon the catwalk. There was no confirmation if they were functional.
- The west head between T3 and T4 was an indication found on the outer diameter of the weld profile. This was Shear-wave UT'd (see UT-1828-01-MAJ) for the shear-wave results on the West Head.

Recommendations:

- Have the indication repaired on the west head prior to putting back into service.
- Review TOFD results from 3rd party (FOCUS) NDE company.
- Label PSV (with serial number 15541) 603SVVP005 and reattach the nameplate.

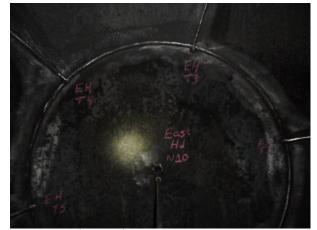


Photo 9: East Head Overview

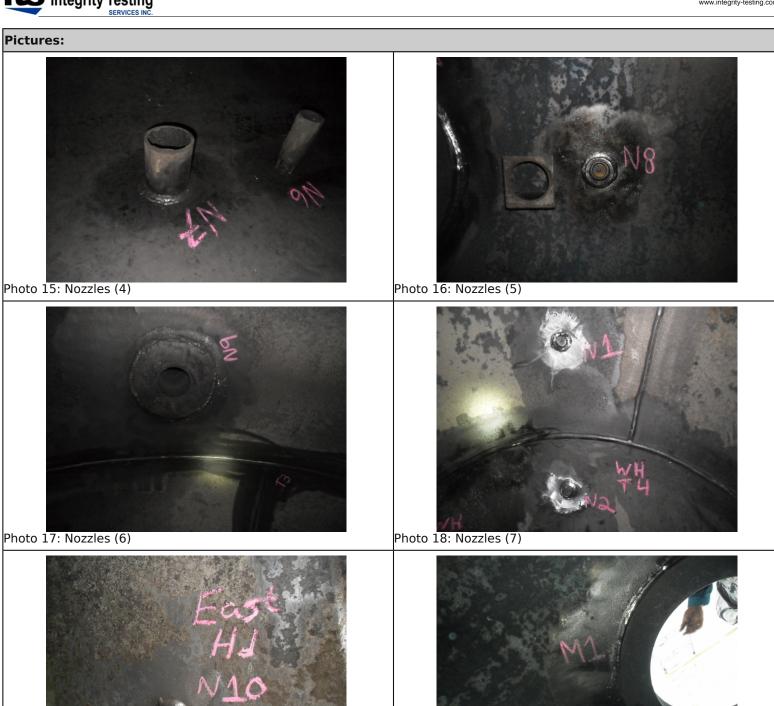
