Pump Repair Estimate:

Disassembly:

- Receive and completely dismantle pump
- Sand blast and clean all necessary pump components
- Positively identify the pump component materials
- Complete as found inspection to develop and provide the official pump repair estimate

Pump Casing:

- Completely sand blast pump casings
- Inspect split line mounting faces for flatness and document
- Inspect case bore diameters and document
- Liquid penetrate the balance line, inspecting for cracks
- Ultra sonic test the balance line determining the integrity of the balance line
- Map out the groove locations and sizes
- Weld Repair:
 - Weld repair the volute cut waters and the washed areas, hand dressing to final profile
 - Weld build up 3 NPT connections
 - Weld the pump case bores 2" below the split line
 - Weld the pressure side of the grooves
 - Weld the non-drive end stuffing box bore
 - Weld the mechanical seal stud holes and necessary pressure faces
 - Weld the dowel pin holes at the bearing housing mounting faces
- Inspect the mounting feet and lightly machine true if required
- Plane the pump cases split line mounting faces
- Line bore and machine the faces true then dowel the pump case
- Machine the suction and discharge gasket surfaces
- Re-drill and tap the 3 NPT connections
- Drill all the pump lid stud holes to ensure case stud clearance
- Bi-metal / hand dress the two pump case halves to ensure the same profile
- De-burr and clean the pump case
- Hydro-test the pump case
- Replace pump case studs
- Replace dowel pins

Bearing Housings:

- Glass bead blast bearing housings and covers •
- Clean and inspect bearing housings for concentricity, skim machine as required
- Weld the dowel pin holes
- Lightly skim machine the radial bearing outside diameters to acceptable tolerance
- Repair the inside diameters of both radial sleeve bearings by re-babbitting and grinding to acceptable tolerance
- Glyptol bearing housing internals
- Replace the roller thrust bearing assemblies
- Inspect the oil flinger rings for roundness, replace if necessary
- Clean and re-use labyrinth seals

Rotating Element:

- Dismantle and glass bead blast rotating element components and inspect
- Pump shaft:
 - Manufacture and install Nitronic 50 pump shaft
 - o Burnish the
- Impellers:
 - Remove all the impeller hub side wear rings
 - Remove all the impeller eye side wear rings
 - Determine if enough wall thickness is available for the wear ring lands can be lightly machined. If wall thickness is not enough welding and extra cost's will be required
 - Weld repair the damaged impeller vanes and hand-dress back to an acceptable profile
 - Completely weld the impeller bores and keyways
 - Re-machine the impeller bores to acceptable dimension concentric with the wear ring land surfaces
 - o Re-cut the impeller keyways in the original position
 - Manufacture 316 Stainless steel impeller hub side wear rings with a Stellite overlav
 - Manufacture 316 SS impeller eye side wear rings with a Stellite overlay
 - Install and tack weld all the wear rings in position
 - As needed skim high spots on finished wear rings to ensure concentricity
 - Individually balance impellers to meeting a 4W/N tolerance
- Stationary case-wear rings:
 - Manufacture 316 SS hub side case wear rings with a Stellite overlay
 - Manufacture 316 SS eye side case wear rings with Stellite overlay
- De-staged ring:
 - Manufacture 316 SS ring
- Throttle bushina:
 - Manufacture 316 SS throttle bushing with Stellite overlay
