

PROTECTION AND CO-ORDINATION SCHEME

- 1. THE 25kV FUSES WILL ACT AS THE SOLE PROTECTION ELEMENT FOR TRANSFORMER T1 AT PRIMARY AND SECONDARY WINDINGS.
- GENERATOR C.B.105 WILL ACT AS THE INTERFACE BREAKER AS WELL AS PRIMARY PROTECTION
- ELEMENT FOR THE GENERATOR WHEN IT IS CONNECTED IN PARALLEL OPERATION MODE. C.B. 52-A WILL ACT AS SECONDARY PROTECTION ELEMENT.
- 3. IN PARALLEL OPERATION MODE, IF A SHORT CIRCUIT OCCURS BETWEEN THE GENERATOR TERMINALS AND BUS BAR BB-1, C.B.105 WILL TRIP FASTER THAN C.B. 52-A TO CLEAR THE FAULT AND MAINTAIN THE POWER SUPPLIED BY THE UTILITY FEEDING THE BOP LOADS
- 4. C.B. 52-B WILL ACT AS THE PRIMARY PROTECTION FOR THE B.O.P. LOADS 5. C.B. 52-C WILL ACT AS THE PRIMARY PROTECTION ELEMENT FOR ORC SYSTEM LOADS
- 6. C.B. 52-E WILL ACT AS THE PRIMARY PROTECTION ELEMENT FOR THE POWER FACTOR CORRECTION
- CAPACITORS (PFCC) C.B. 52-F WILL ACT AS THE PRIMARY PROTECTION ELEMENT FOR THE MCC LOADS
- 8. C.B. 52-G WILL ACT AS THE PRIMARY PROTECTION ELEMENT FOR THE AIR-COOLED CONDENSER AND
- ITS MOTORS 9. C.B. 52-A WILL ACT AS THE SECONDARY PROTECTION ELEMENT FOR C.B. 52-B, C.B. 52-C, C.B. 52-E, C.B. 52-F AND C.B. 52-G

- 1CT, 2000/5A IS SUPPLIED BY THE PFCC MANUFACTURER AND HAS AN INTERNAL OPENING WHICH IS 4.1" x 7.1" (104 x 180mm); THE BUS BAR MUST BE ABLE TO ACCOMMODATE THIS BREAKERS AS FOLLOWS
- 52 A MOTORIZED BREAKER (ELECTRICALLY AND/OR MANUALLY OPERATED)
- 52 B M.C.C.B. 52 - C M.C.C.B. 52 - E M.C.C.B.
- 52 F M.C.C.B. 52 - G M.C.C.B.

SEQUENCE OF OPERATION - CONNECT G1 TO THE GRID

- CLOSE SWITCH S1; THE PRIMARY WINDING OF TRANSFORMER T1 WILL BE ENERGIZED
- CLOSE ISOLATING SWITCH HA (OR HB) INSIDE T1 CLOSE TRANSFORMER ISOLATING SWITCH AT 25kV SIDE OF T1
- CLOSE UTILITY MAIN CIRCUIT BREAKER AT 480V SIDE OF T1
- CLOSE CIRCUIT BREAKER 52-A; 480V WILL BE AVAILABLE AT BUS-BAR BB-1 CLOSE CIRCUIT BREAKER 52-B: 480V WILL BE AVAILABLE AT BUS-BAR BB-2
- CLOSE C.B. 52-F; POWER WILL BE AVAILABLE TO THE M.C.C. TO START/RUN THE PLANT AUXILIARY LOADS
- 8. CLOSE THE C.B. FEEDING TRANSFORMER T2; VOLTAGE SIGNAL 208V/120V WILL BE SUPPLIED TO THE PLC AND INSTRUMENT SYSTEM THROUGH THE U.P.S. (NOTE: IT IS POSSIBLE TO START THE PLC &
- INSTRUMENTATION THROUGH THE UPS BATTERIES BEFORE ENERGIZING TRANSFORMER T2) 9. CLOSE C.B. 52-C; 480V WILL BE SUPPLIED TO THE ORC CUPBOARD. START THE ORC LOADS ON THE SKID.
- 10. CLOSE C.B. 52-G; 480V WILL BE SUPPLIED TO A/C CONDENSER VFD. THE SPEED OF ALL CONDENSER FANS WILL BE DETERMINED BY THE OUTLET WATER TEMPERATURE. 11. START THE ORC SYSTEM & RUN THE GENERATOR UNTIL IT REACHES A SPEED HIGHER THAN
- SYNCHRONIZING SPEED
- 12. AS SOON AS THERE IS PROOF OF RECOMMENDED SPEED, PROOF OF GENERATOR AND TRANSFORMER RESET, THE PLC WILL SEND A SIGNAL TO CLOSE C.B. CB 105 AND POWER WILL FLOW FROM THE GENERATOR TO THE GRID
- 13. WHEN THE GENERATOR IS AT PARALLEL OPERATION MODE, THE PLC WILL SEND A "START" SIGNAL TO THE PFCC TO LOAD/UNLOAD THE CAPACITORS (AS REQUIRED) IN STAGES ACCORDING TO THE MANUFACTURER'S INSTRUCTIONS.
