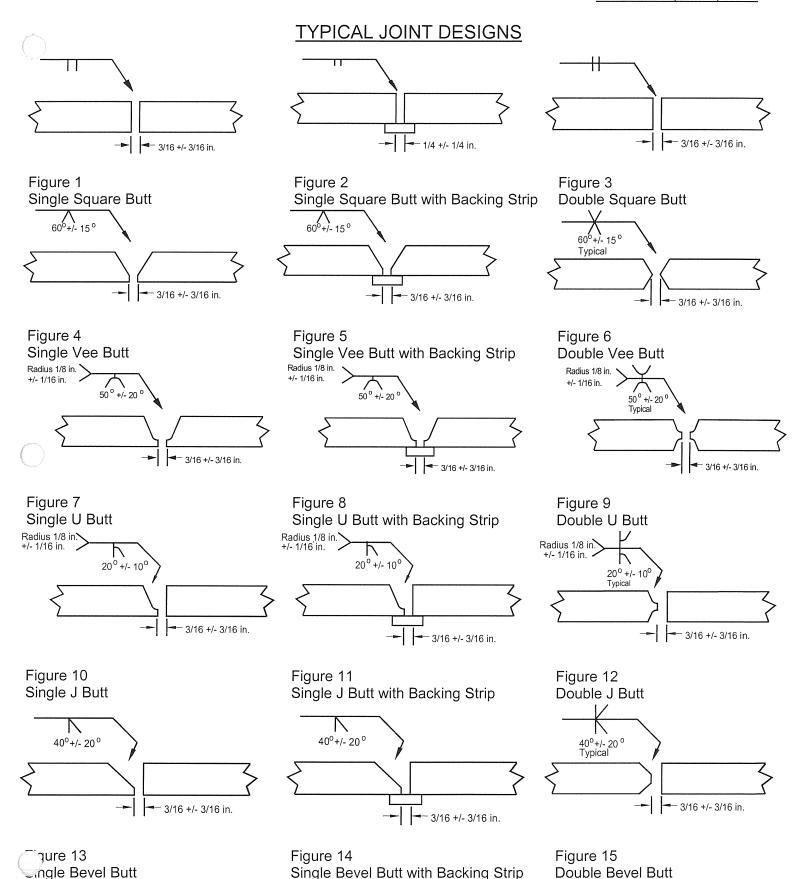

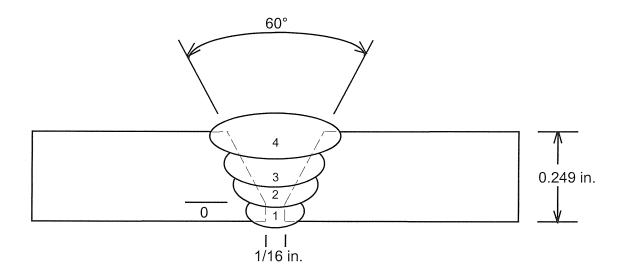


Single Bevel Butt with Backing Strip

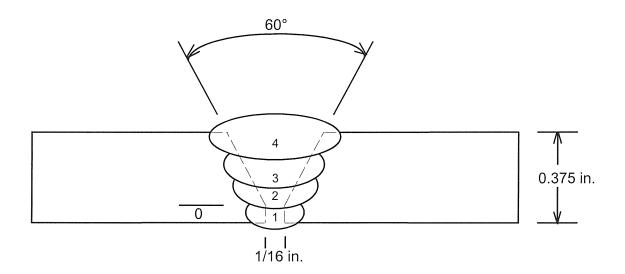

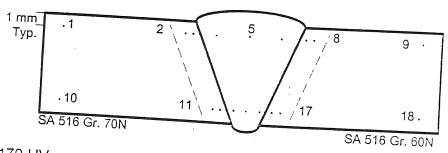

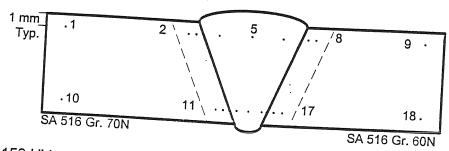
