Magnetic Particle Inspection Comments:

Wet Visible Magnetic Particle Inspection (WVMPI) and Wet Fluorescent Magnetic Particle Inspection (WFMPI) were performed on two, 2" cut outs prior to a new liquid level bridle being installed. No cracks or other indications were found at the time of inspection.

Wet Visible Magnetic Particle Inspection (WVMPI) was also performed on all of the new liquid level bridle attachment welds. No indications were found.

Post Welding:

Wet Visible Magnetic Particle Inspection (WVMPI) and Wet Fluorescent Magnetic Particle Inspection (WFMPI) were performed on the completed welds, 24 hours after the completion of the weld, to ensure no cracks or other welding defects were present in the weld and heat affected zones. No rejectable indications were found at the time of inspection.

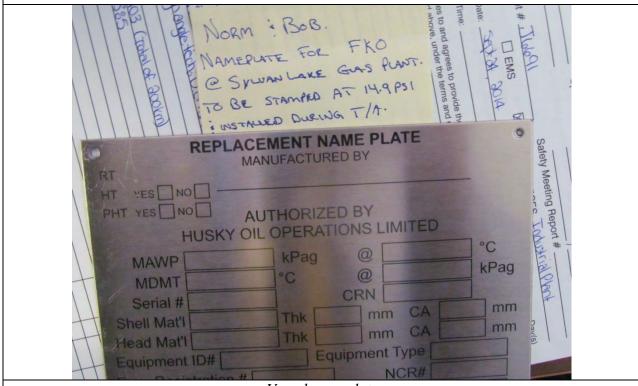

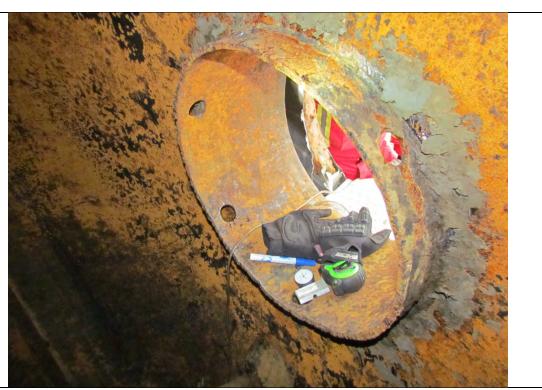

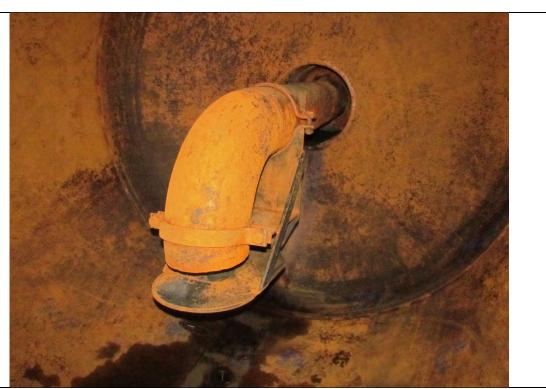
