## **Definitions**

#### **Wear and Conditions**

Bent - Altered from an originally straight or even condition.

Blown - (Specific to bellows) pressure has exceeded the operational limits of the bellows and has resulted in the catastrophic failure of the part.

Catastrophic Wear - Rapidly occurring or accelerating surface damage, deterioration, or change of shape caused by wear to such a degree that the service life of the part is appreciably shortened or its function is destroyed.

Collapsed - (Specific to Farris gaskets) the corrugations in the metal gasket are no longer functioning to form part of the seal.

Corrosion - the gradual destruction of metal due to a chemical reaction with the environment characterized by rust, pitting and pinhole porosity

Cracked - a break without the complete separation of parts.

Dirty -requires cleaning only.

**Eroded** - a form of wear in which there is a progressive loss of original material from a solid surface due to mechanical interaction between that surface and a fluid.

**Galling** - A form of surface damage arising between two sliding solids, distinguished by roughening, and the creation of protrusions above the original surface and may involve material transfer.

Marked -surface is showing abrasions that will alter or hinder valve performance.

Missing - There is a part listed on the manufacturers parts list, critical to the designed operation, which has been found absent and unaccounted for.

Nonconcentric - the deformation of a circular part in which there is an absence of a common center.

Non-OEM - a part identified as not being from the original equipment manufacturer.

Out of Tolerance - a specific dimension has been determined to be out of the stated acceptable range listed by the manufacturer.

Pinhole Porosity - small spaces in a material characterized by small holes appearing porous; compromising the isolation of a pressure zone.

**Pitting** - A form of wear characterized by the presence of surface cavities the formation of which is attributed to processes such as fatigue, local adhesion, or cavitation.

Requires Replacement - The particular part needs to be changed out in order to meet the construction and/or operational requirements as specified by the valve owner.

Scoring - A severe form of wear characterized by the formation of extensive grooves and scratches in the direction of sliding.

**Seized** - Two parts are jammed together to become stuck and cannot be removed by conventional means.

Spalling - (Specific to seats) the separation of material from a surface in the form of flakes or chips resulting from an impact event.
