# 1 SCOPE

1.1 This Welding Procedure Specification (WPS) covers welding and related operations of steel structures, which are fabricated by RJV Gasfield Services in accordance with the terms outlined in:

> CSA Standard W47.1 - 2009 CSA Standard W59 - 2013

- **1.2** This Welding Procedure Specification shall be limited to:
  - a) Welding of base metal listed in Table 3.1.
  - b) Use of filler metal which conforms to CSA W48 and listed in Table 5.1.
  - c) Base metal thickness from 3 mm (1/8") to unlimited thickness.
  - d) Joints conform to the annex of this WPS: Pregualified Joint Details.
- **1.3** Approved Welding Procedure Data Sheet(s) (WPDS) are required to supplement this Welding Procedure Specification (WPS) when:
  - a) Contract documents specify impact/toughness/charpy/CVN values, PWHT or other mechanical property requirements
  - b) A change in any of the variables contained in the succeeding paragraphs or listed in Clause 11.
- 1.4 In case of conflict or discrepancy between an approved Welding Procedure Data Sheet (WPDS) making reference to this specification, the WPDS requirements shall apply.

# 2 WELDING PROCEDURE

## 2.1 General

- 2.1.1 Welding shall be done using automatic or semi-automatic FCAW (Flux Cored Arc Welding) gas shielded or self-shielded process in single and multi-pass welds welded using a stringer pass technique.
- 2.1.2 Maximum and minimum electrode diameters shall be as per table 2.1a:
- 2.1.3 Maximum fillet weld made in one pass shall be as per table 2.1b:

- 2.1.4 Thickness of weld layers shall not exceed 6 mm (1/4 inch).
- 2.1.5 Split layer technique shall be used when the width of the layer exceeds 16 mm (5/8 inch) and 25 mm (1") for vertical up. When the root opening of a groove weld is 12 mm (1/2 inch) split layer technique shall be used with the exception of the finishing weld layers.

# 2.2 Complete Joint Penetration Groove Welds

- 2.2.1 Complete penetration groove welds, welded from both shall be backgouged to sound metal prior to welding from the other side except where it is expressly stated that backgouging is not mandatory.
- 2.2.2 Back-gouging shall produce a groove contour substantially conforming to the prequalified single U-joint and its depth shall be adequate to ensure complete penetration into the previously deposited weld metal.
- 2.2.3 Groove welds to be used without procedure qualification are detailed in Annex and are subject to the limitations specified in Clauses 10.4.1 and Fig.10.5 of CSA W59 within the following limits:
  - a) The groove angle as shown is the minimum permitted.
  - b) The radius of the J- and U-grooves is a minimum permitted dimension. U-grooves may be prepared before or after fitting.
  - c) Double groove welds may have grooves of unequal depth.



#### 2.3 Partial Penetration Groove Welds

- 2.3.1 Minimum depth of grooves shall be as shown in Table 4.3 of CSA W59, which is reproduced in this document as Table 2.2.
- 2.3.2 Groove welds to be used without procedure qualification are detailed in Annex and are subject to the limitations specified in Clause 10.4.2 and Fig. 10.6 of CSA W59 and within the following limits:
  - a) The groove angle as shown is the minimum permitted.
  - **b)** The radius of the J- and U-grooves is a minimum permitted dimension. U-grooves may be prepared before or after fitting.
  - c) Double groove welds may have grooves of unequal depth.

**Note:** The size of any single-pass weld or the size of the first pass of a multiple-pass weld shall be such as to minimize the possibility of cracking.

# 3 BASE METAL

- 3.1 The base metal of 3.2mm (1/8") minimum thickness shall be as shown in CSA W59: Table 11.1, Steel Groups 1 to 7; or in Table 12.1, Steel Groups 1 to 7. This information has been adapted as part of this specification in Table 3.1.
- 3.2 This specification in not intended to apply to quenched and tempered steel without additional considerations from CSA W59 or any steel other than those listed in Table 3.1 of this specification.

\*ASTM A252 material specification has no limitations on chemical elements with the exception of phosphorus. This lack of control on chemical composition may lead to the production of material, which is not considered weldable due to high carbon equivalents or high sulphur levels. This material can be used in accordance with Clause 3.2 in CSA Standard W59 if the following conditions are being met:

- a)  $S \le 0.05$  and  $P \le 0.04$ , and
- b) Carbon equivalent (C.E.) of the material shall be less than 0.50 using C.E. = C + (Mn+Si)/6 + (Cr+Mo+V)/5 + (Ni+Cu)/15
- c) Mechanical properties are similar to those of prequalified materials listed in CSA Standard W59.

- (1) For exceptions, see CSA W59 tables 12.2
- (2) In case of exception under Note (1) for electrodes lower than matching, the value of  $X_u$  is that of the lower electrode classification; for electrodes higher than matching, the value of  $X_u$  is that of the matching electrode classification.
- (3) For unpainted applications where the deposited weld metal shall have similar atmospheric corrosion resistance and/or similar colour characteristics to the base metal, the requirements of Clauses 5.2.1.4 and 5.2.1.5 in CSA W59 shall apply.
- (4) Only types with properties suitable for welding
- (5) Complete joint penetration groove welds made with the designated matching electrodes classifications may not develop the specified minimum tensile strength of the base metal.
- (6) NA
- (7) FCAW wire electrodes shall have a low hydrogen designator of –H8, or –H4.



# 4 PREPARATION OF BASE METAL

- **4.1** The base material and assembly shall be prepared in accordance with Clause 5.3 and 5.4 of CSA W59 with the limitation of table 4.1 below.
- **4.2** Surfaces and edges to be welded shall be smooth, uniform, and free from fins, cracks, and other defects that would adversely affect the quality or strength of the weld.
- **4.3** Surfaces to be welded shall also be free, within 50 mm (2 in) of any weld locations, from loose or thick scale (except for tightly adhering small islands of scale), slag, loose rust, paint, grease, moisture, and other foreign material that will prevent welding or produce objectionable fumes while welding.
- 4.4 Machining, grinding, air carbon-arc or oxygen gouging may be used for joint preparation, back gouging, or the removal of defective work material except that oxygen-fuel gouging shall not be used on quenched and tempered steels..
- 4.5 All slag, flux, blow holes or porosity remaining on any bead of welding shall be removed before laying down the next successive bead.

# 5 FILLER METAL / SHIELDING GAS

## 5.1 General

5.1.1 The filler metal shall conform to the requirements of CSA W48, latest edition, and shall be selected from Table 3.1.



# 5.2 Storage of Electrodes

- 5.2.1 Electrodes shall be dry and free from rust and foreign material.
- 5.2.2 All rolls of wire shall be stored in warm and dry conditions and kept free from oil, grease, and other deleterious matter once they have been removed from their packages.

# 5.3 Shielding Gas

- 5.3.1 Shielding gas mixture may only be used when electrode (wire) manufacturer's recommendations on shielding gas / wire electrode combinations are permissible under CSA W48 latest edition, and specified in Table 9.1.
- 5.3.2 The shielding gas shall be a welding grade having a dew point of -40°C (-40°F) or lower.
- 5.3.3 The use of mixtures of argon with carbon dioxide (CO2) and/or oxygen (O2), with or without the additions of helium, increase the levels of manganese and silicon in the weld deposits compared with carbon dioxide (CO2) shielding. Increasing the amount of alloy elements in the weld metal may result in higher tensile and yield strength and correspondingly lower elongations. Impact properties may also be affected.
- 5.3.4 Gas flow shall be as indicated in Table 9.1.
- 5.3.5 Shielding must be provided for the arc area to reduce drafts below 6km/h.

# **6 WELDING TECHNIQUES**

- Welding shall be done preferably in the flat position. Horizontal, Vertical, and Overhead positions are acceptable when shown on applicable prequalified joint welding detail in Annex except for the root pass which can be done in any position or progression when it is removed to sound metal in preparation for welding the second side.
- 6.2 The travel angle is the angle between the joint and electrode in the longitudinal plane along the joint and referred to as a push angle when the electrode points in the direction of travel and a drag angle when the electrode points in the direction opposite to travel.
- 6.3 The work angle is the angle between the work and the electrode in the plane perpendicular to travel. That is; a transverse plane across the joint.



- 6.4 In general the following techniques and critical electrode angles shall be used or follow techniques and electrode angles which are recommended by the electrode manufacturer:
  - a) Work angle range is from 40° to 90° and 5° to 15° drag angle. Push angle is only to be used with FCAW processes progressing upwards in the vertical position.
  - b) Stay on the leading edge of the puddle to avoid inadequate fusion. Refer to minimum Arc Travel Speed (ATS) and typical parameter ranges. in Table 9.1.
  - c) Welding operators should avoid techniques that could involve a danger of cold lapping or non-fusion and undercutting. Stringer beads are preferred; weaving or shipping of gun shall be avoided.
- 6.5 The wire diameter, voltage, and amperage shall be suited to the thickness of the material, type and groove, welding position and other circumstances associated with the assembly.

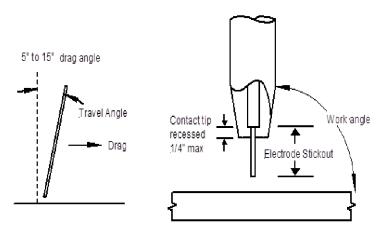

# 7 PREHEAT AND INTERPASS TEMPERATURE

- 7.1 Unless otherwise specified by the drawings or Engineer minimum preheat and interpass temperature shall be in accordance with values from Table 5.3 of CSA W59 which has been adapted in this specification in Table 7.1.
- **7.2** Preheat and interpass temperatures above the minimum shown in Table 7.1 may be required:
  - a) for highly restrained welds
  - b) for certain combinations of steel thickness and weld energy input levels when the steel composition contains elements such as Carbon, Manganese, Chromium, Nickel that are at or near the maximum values permitted by the steel specifications
  - c) for high strength weld metal
  - d) for joints where transfer of tensile stress occurs in the through-thickness direction of the material.

- (1) Only for thicknesses up to 8 mm (5/16").
- (2) Grades suitable for welding. See clause 3.2.2
- (3) When the base metal temperature is below 0°C (32°F), the base metal shall be preheated to at least 10°C (50°F) and this temperature maintained during welding.

- Welding shall not be done when the ambient temperature is below -18°C (0°F), except with the expressed consent of the
  engineer.
- When the base metal is below the temperature listed for the welding process being used and for the thickness of the material being welded, it shall be preheated (except as otherwise provided) in such a manner that the surfaces of the parts on which weld metal is being deposited are at or above the specified minimum temperature for a distance equal to the thickness of the part being welded – but not less than 75 mm (3") – both laterally and in advance of the welding. Preheat and interpass temperatures must be sufficient to prevent crack formation.
- For quenched and tempered steel, the maximum preheat and interpass temperature shall not exceed 200 °C (400°F) for thicknesses up to 40 mm (1-1/2 ") inclusive and 230 °C (450°F) for greater thicknesses. Heat input, when welding quenched and tempered steel, shall not exceed the steel producer's recommendations.



# 8 WELD METAL CLEANING

- **8.1** Flux, slag, or silica remaining after a layer shall be removed before applying the next covering pass. Prior to painting all flux, slag, and silica shall be removed and the parts shall be free of loose scale, or dirt.
- **8.2** Prior to depositing weld metal on the underside of welding groove the root shall be gouged, ground, or chipped to sound metal unless otherwise specified on the applicable prequalified joint detail in Annex.
- **8.3** Groove welds shall be terminated at the ends of a joint in a manner that will ensure sound welds. Where possible, this shall be done by use of extension bars or run-off plates. When used, extensions shall be removed upon completion and cooling of the weld. The ends of the welds shall be made smooth and flush with the edges of the abutting parts.
- **8.4** Tack welds that are incorporated into the final weld shall be made with electrodes meeting the requirements of the final welds and shall be cleaned thoroughly.
- 8.5 Unless otherwise noted, tack welds that are located in areas not included in the final welds shall either be removed and ground smooth or build up to sizes equivalent to minimum fillet size requirements.

# 9 ELECTRICAL CHARACTERISTICS

- **9.1** The electrical power source used shall be a Constant Voltage (CV) type.
- **9.2** The welding current, voltage, polarity, electrode (wire) and gas combinations shall be as outlined in published data from electrode (wire) manufacturer and as per Table 9.1.
- 9.3 The welding current or wire feed speed, arc voltage, gas flow, mode of metal transfer, and speed of travel shall be such that each pass will have complete fusion with adjacent base metal and weld metal and there shall be no overlap or excessive porosity or undercutting.

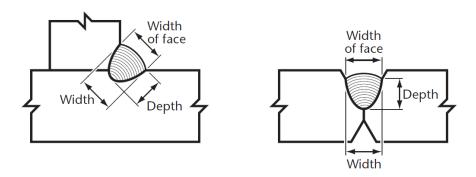

# 10 QUALITY

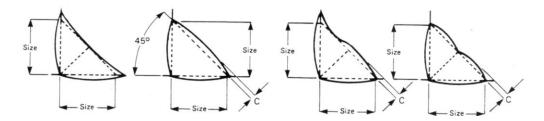
- **10.1** Cracks or blow holes that appear on the surface of any pass shall be removed before depositing the next covering pass.
- **10.2** Welds shall be free from overlap.
- **10.3** Undercutting shall be minimized by selecting the most suitable process and procedure and applying the correct technique.
- **10.4** Arc strikes outside the weld area are to be avoided.

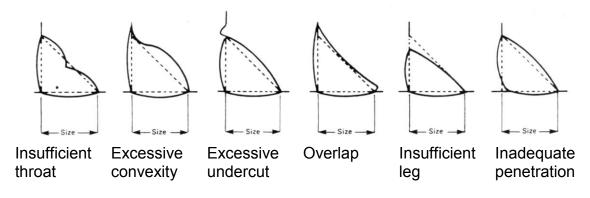
Figure 10.1 Width to Depth Ratio

- **10.5** Fillet and butt weld profiles shall meet the requirements in Clause 5.9 and Figure 5.3 of CSA W59 which is reproduced as part of this specification and shown in Figure 10.1.
- **10.6** If nondestructive examination is not specified in the contract documents or drawings it shall be done in accordance with Clause 11.5.4 and 12.5.4 of CSA W59.
- 10.7 Neither the depth nor the maximum width in the cross- section of weld metal deposited in each weld pass shall exceed the width of the face of the weld pass as shown in Figure 10.1.



Depth and width shall not exceed the width of face

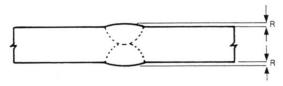


# a) Desirable Fillet Weld Profiles b) Acceptable Fillet Weld Profiles

Note: Convexity, C, shall not exceed 0.1S + 1.5 mm (.06")

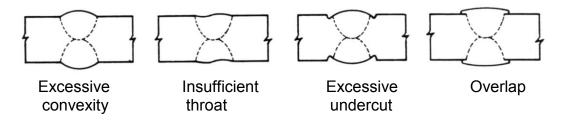


# c) Unacceptable Fillet Weld Profiles

# 11 ESSENTIAL VARIABLES

- **11.1** A change in any of the following essential variables shall require the use of different welding procedure specifications (WPS) and associated welding procedure data sheets (WPDS):
  - a) A change to <u>filler metal</u> classification not covered in CSA Standard W48 (see Clause 11.8 CSA W47.1).
  - b) A change to **electrical characteristics** not shown in Clause 9, Table 9.1.
  - c) A decrease in voltage or amperage below the minimum as defined in Table 9.1
  - d) A decrease in **Arc Travel Speed** below the minimum as defined in Table 9.1.
  - e) The <u>omission of steel backing</u> material or the substitution of other than steel backing material.
  - f) A change form backgouging or backing plate to **non-backgouging**.
  - g) A change in the **mode of metal transfer** except for the root pass when it is removed to sound weld metal in preparation for welding the second side.
  - h) A change from upward to downward or from downward to upward in the **progression** specified for any pass of a vertical weld. Except that the root pass may run either up or down when the root pass is removed to sound weld metal in preparation for welding the second side.
  - i) A change of <u>fillet welds larger than the single-pass</u> size and/or smaller than the multiple-pass size shown on prequalified joint details and/or smaller than single pass size shown in Table 4.4 of CSA W59.
  - j) A change in welding process (es).
  - k) A decrease in minimum **preheat** temperature as defined in Table 7.1.
  - I) A change to base metal or **steel group** not listed in Table 3.1.
  - m) A change in shielding gas or **omission of gas shielding** not listed in Table 9.1.
  - n) A change in electrode wire diameter not listed in Table 9.1.
