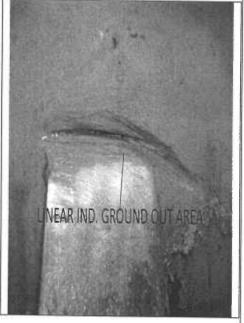

RESULTS: 1-3" LONG CRACK WAS FOUND. THE INDICATION WAS THEN GROUND AND REMPI'D UNTILL GONE. THE CRACK HAD PROPAGATED RIGHT THROUGH THE SHELL. THE GROUND AREA WAS THEN ROOTED, WELDER: "KM". AFTER COOLING THE ROOT AREA WAS MPI'D. NO INDICATIONS OF DEFECTS WERE PRESENT. THE GROUND AREA WAS THEN FILLED AND CAPPED. FINAL MPI FOUND WELD TOBE ACCEPTABLE TO CODE.
