

The "Ask me about Quakerism" game

The scene –

You have set up a table covered with Quaker literature on the sidewalk in front of a library, school or BART station. Above the table is a sign saying "Ask me about Quakerism". You sit down behind the table and wait for people to ask you questions. (No way can this be considered proselytization!)

Preparation -

- 1) Place questions on folded slips of paper in a bowl. The file contains 65 questions - some easy, some hard for anyone to answer.
- 2) Place role assignment slips in another bowl. There is one "Answerer", three Questioners and enough "Listener" slips for everyone else (but no more) in the bowl. Optionally, you can add more Questioners to make the Answerer's job harder.
- 3) Optionally, place question topics in another bowl. This makes the job of the Questioners harder - they have to think of a question to fit the topic.

Play the game –

Pass the bowl with assignment slips around and everybody takes one. The Answerer goes to sit at the table (or the center of the circle, if no table). Take the bowl of questions to each Questioner, or take both pre-written questions and topics and let them choose one from either bowl. The Questioners ask their questions in order (#1, #2, ...) and the Answerer answers as fast as he/she can. Saying "I don't know" is allowed if followed by a plan to find the answer.

Conclusion –

Collect the role slips and mix them back in their bowl. Collect question slips but do not mix them back in the bowl until all rounds have been played. Start the next round by passing the role bowl around again. In a small group, you may draw "Answerer" more than once. Continue until the point has been thoroughly demonstrated.

[Done first as an interest group at Fall, 2011, CPQM, with about 10 participants. Four actually were new to Quakerism and came to ask their own questions; if they drew the "Answerer" card, they were excused]
