For 11 O'clock Worship

Welcome to Eugene Friends Meeting. We stopped meeting in-person due to the Covid-19 pandemic. Now our Quaker Community is taking another step towards gathering in-person. We are being asked to consider the current limitations, weigh the risks, let Spirit lead, and make an individual choice:

By entering the Meeting House, I affirm that I am in compliance with the following protocols.

If you cannot meet these conditions:

Please join us virtually at 9 O'clock or 11 O'clock via Zoom or
Join the Walking Worship offered by individual Friends.

Here are the conditions to consider. Please do not attend if you:

Within the past 14 days have had unprotected close contact with anyone
who has Covid-19 signs or symptoms,

OR Within the past 3 days have experienced signs or symptoms of the Covid-19
Virus yourself. Signs and symptoms include:

Fever	Shortness of breath	Dry cough
Sore throat	Runny nose	Nasal congestion
Nausea, vomiting	Diarrhea	Dizziness
Loss of smell or taste	Muscle aches	General weakness
Chills	Headache	

If you come to the Meeting House:

- Enter from the West Room Door (Up the Ramp)—exit from any door
- Use hand sanitizer or wash your hands upon entry
- By entering, I affirm that I am in compliance with these protocols, and I agree to:
 - Maintain social distancing (6 foot)
 - Wear appropriate face masks
 - Bring a personal water bottle
 - Refrain from eating or singing while in the building

West Room = 10 persons

Restrooms = 1 to 2 persons

Library = 2 persons (once it is back in order)
