The first book of Moses, called

GENESIS

Chapter 1, paragraph 1-5: “In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth,...and the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters.

And God said, Let there be Light, and there was Light. And saw the light, that it was good; and God divided the light from the darkness, and God called the light “DAY,” and darkness he called “NIGHT.”

And the evening and the morning were the first day.”

Ch. 1, pp. 6, 7, & 8: “And God said, Let there be a firmament in the midst of the waters, and the firmament divided the waters which were below from the waters which were above; and God called the firmament HEAVEN.

And the evening and the morning were the second day.”

Ch. 1, pp. 9-13: “And God said, let the waters be gathered together in one place, and let dry land appear. And he called the dry land “EARTH,” and he called the waters the “SEAS,” and God saw that it was good.

And God said, Let the earth bring forth grass and herbs yielding seed, and fruit trees yielding fruit. And the earth brought forth the grass and the fruit trees, and God saw that it was good.

Ch. 1, pp. 14-19: “And God said, Let there be lights in Heaven to divide night from day, and let them give light upon the earth, and it was so.

And God made two great lights: the greater light to rule the day, and the lesser light to rule the night. He made the stars also. And God saw that it was good.

And the evening and the morning were the fourth day.”

Ch. 1, pp.20-23: And God created great whales and every living creature that moved, and every bird, and God saw that it was good.

And god blessed them, saying be fruitful and multiply, and fill the waters in the seas, and let birds multiply in the earth.

And the evening and the morning were the fifth day.”

Ch. 1, pp. 24-31: And God said, let the earth bring forth every living thing, the cattle, and every living thing. And God saw that it was good.

And God said, let us make man in our own image. So God created man in his own image, male and female he created.

And God blessed them and said, be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth...

And God saw every thing that he had made, and behold, it was very good. And the evening and morning were the sixth day.”

Ch. 2, pp. 1-3. “Thus the heavens and the earth were finished.

And on the seventh day God ended his work, and he rested on the seventh day from all the work he had made.

And God blessed the seventh day.”
